



Cremated Remains Sections - Conditions Covering Burial

- 1. The Exclusive Right of Burial is granted for a period of 100 years dating from the first burial.
- 2. All memorials should be no greater than:
 - a memorial tablet 18inches by 18 inches laid flat and level with the surrounding ground.

Memorial kerbs are not allowed

Purchased Graves in Lawn Section - Conditions Covering Burial

- 1. The Exclusive Right of Burial is granted for a period of 100 years dating from the first burial.
- 2. The whole of the grave space will be turfed flat and mown by Cemetery staff.
- 3. All memorials should be a maximum of 4 feet in height, by 33 inches in width.
